Preparation for the Laboratory and Prerequisites

- Each group (no. 1 & 2) must be divided into 6 lab teams of two-person and 2 lab teams of 3 person that will perform laboratory exercises.
- The two-person laboratory teams must be numbered. The laboratory team number means the number of the exercise being performed. During one laboratory class, each team performs two exercises with numbers: number of a team and number of a team plus one. For example the team no. 1 is going to perform two exercises number 1 and 2.
